

**Still and moving images** are extremely effective tools to engage pupils in learning. When used efficiently they engage and motivate pupils of all levels and can greatly augment teaching and learning.

**ICTinspires** offer training in the use of digital imagery and video to enhance the use of ICT and literacy across the curriculum. This half day session is a general introduction to making short films and investigates the potential of digital media for learning and teaching. Resources will be demonstrated and shared and all participants will have the opportunity to create their own short film.

#### Content:

With teaching backgrounds we know that teachers want the most from any training. Our multi-modal session will be hands on with lots of ideas to take back to the classroom. The session will include:

- An introduction to working with digital images.
- Use of cameras in the classroom and the practicalities involved.
- Use of MS Photo Story 3 to create a collection of images with music.
- Discussions of how children can use digital video in the classroom
- Investigating film resources on line
- Examples of how to plan a filming activity and use of different filming techniques (framing, types of shot, camera movement etc.)
- How to use a digital video camera and transfer film to a computer
- How to use a video editing package (Movie Maker) to assemble film clips and stills and material from other sources
- How to add voiceovers, music, titles, captions and credits
- How to save and publish the film in a suitable file format
- Giving teachers directed time to explore and experiment with the demonstrated ideas



All software used in this session is free of charge and is available for schools to download to all school computers.
